**Call for Entries for Art Show  
The H<sub>2</sub>O Show**

**Norwalk CT, January 6, 2010** – St. Philip Artists' Guild (SPAG) has issued a call for entries to local artists to submit pieces for a juried show on the theme of water.

The show will hang in the SPAG gallery in the historic Mansion on the grounds of St. Philip Church, 25 France Street, Norwalk, CT. The opening reception is Friday, February 26 from 7-9pm and the show will continue through Sunday, April 25, 2010.

The show will be juried by artist/educator Christine Goldbach, most recently co-curator at the Carriage Barn in New Canaan and is open to artists in all media. Artists selected for the show will be asked to donate a small percentage of any sales to the St. Philip Youth Group fundraiser that is raising money to build a well for clean water in a community in Africa.

Drop off for work to be juried is Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, from 5-7pm and Saturday, February 20, from 9-11am at the Mansion, 25 France Street, Norwalk, CT. Work not selected should be picked up Saturday, February 20<sup>th</sup> from 3-5pm at the Mansion. St. Philip Artists' Guild launched in March 2008 with five artists -- Duvian Montoya, David Morico Ralph DiMarco, Deacon Frank Chiappetta and Steve Bagnell. The space in the century-old Mansion was remodeled and converted into twelve studios. The gallery space opened to the public in September 2008. SPAG now has twelve artists-in-residence.
